

Product Update Notice for Essentials for Clinical Documentation Integrity 2021

As part of MedLearn Publishing's quality-control process, we routinely evaluate current publications to make sure they're accurate. We reviewed the Essentials for Clinical Documentation Integrity 2021 and determined that the revisions listed below should be made. To ensure that you have the most up-to-date information, please take a few minutes to note the change, which will be updated in our 2022 publication version.

Page 140 – under the high-risk alert **Pressure Ulcers Stages 3 and 4**, the opening sentence should read:

- If these are **not** both documented as present on admission (POA) they are coded to a HAC! This makes it appear as though the hospital “gave” this patient a PU stages 3 or 4 due to poor care (not turning frequently, inadequate wound care, etc.).
